

# Maurizio Ferri

Master Vincenzo Ferri, born in 1959, began practicing Karate at the very beginning of the 80s with Master Pasquale Trillicoso and obtained the 1st Dan black belt with Master Ilija Yorga's Fudokan.

In October 1991 he obtained the degree of 2nd Dan in sports sector of Fikta. He gets the 3rd Dan in 1994 and the 4th Dan in 1997. On November 4, 2000, in recognition of what has been done under the discipline of Karate at a sporting, didactic level and informative, the President of Fesik Carlo Henke decides to confer on Vincenzo the technical qualification of Master.

In 2002 he became a national referee and obtained the degree of 5th Dan.

The following year he obtained the qualification of Personal Defense Instructor Fesik and in 2004 at the European Championships Wkc, World Karate Confederation, of Caorle becomes International Referee.

The following year at the World Championship of Fortaleza becomes Senior Referee and in October 2008 he obtained from the president of Fesik, Carlo Henke, the rank of 6th Dan.

In 2009 in Imperia he achieves the qualification of Chief Referee at Wuko European Championship. In December 2016 during the 4th Carlo Henke Memorial the Fesik President, Sean Henke, awards him the 7<sup>th</sup> Dan.

Finally in February 2017 the Federal Council of Fesik appoints him President of the National Referees Commission.

From 1985 to today he has participated, like his brother, in numerous stages of technical updates with the greatest National and International Masters of Karate.
