## Juan Ramon Galvez Marin

Lama jampa gyatso Juan Ramon Galvez Marin (Lama Jampa Gyatso) began his studies in 1980 when he met the venerable Kalu Rimpoche in France and received from him the Refuge, the first Dharma teachings and the first monastic vows.

From this great master he received the main teachings of the Shangpa Kagyu and Karma Kagyu School: Six Yogas of Niguma and Six Yogas of Naropa, The Five Golden Teachings, Rinchen



Gyatso Gyu (Tantra of the five deities), Lashi Dridrub, Chekari, Path of Lam Khyer Gsum, and above all the integral teaching of the Truklor of Niguma and Sukhasiddhi.

In 1987 he received the transmission of Gelong from Bokar Tulku Ripoche in the monastery of Kagyu Ling (Montpellier-France). At the same time in the Dordogne he received teachings of Nyiting Menla and the cycle of the tantra of Dorje Phurba (Vajrakilaya) from Dilgo Kyentse Rimpoche and Beru Kyentse Rimpoche.

He knows Lama Gangchen Ripoche in Valencia.

In 1994 he received the complete teaching of Kalachakra from Kirti Rimpoche in Barcelona. From Gheshe Lobsang Tsultrim he receives the complete transmission and initiation of

Yamantaka, Vajrayoghini, Chakrasamvara and the commentary of Lam Rim Chenmo. From Gheshe Tamdin Gyatso receives the commentary on the practices of Vajrayoghini, Chakrasamvara and commentary and transmission of Lama Tsongkhapa's Lama Chopa and Ganden Laghiema (Guru Yoga).

From S.S. The 14th Dalai Lama receives the complete Kalachakra initiation twice: the first time in Barcelona (Spain, 1994) and the second time in Graz (Austria, 2002).

In 2000 he received from S.S. Sakya Trinzin the complete transmission of Padmasambhava's Guru Yoga and the practice of Dorje Phurba. The year after 2001 he received from S.E. Jetsun Chimey Luding (sister of S.S. Sakya Trinzin) the complete initiation of Hevajra with commentary and the complete initiation of Vajrayogini Indra Cacho and Naro Cacho and the commentary on the Thirteen Golden Dharmas (gSer-chos bcu-gsum).

Since 2003 he has received from Lama Gangchen Rimpoche teachings and transmission of the NgalSo Gelug Ganden Nyengyu lineage.
